At Christmas, families **meet together for a huge meal** and **exchange presents** around a decorated tree. Who do you spend Christmas with?



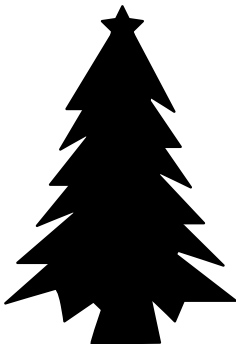
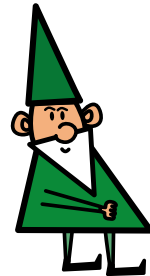
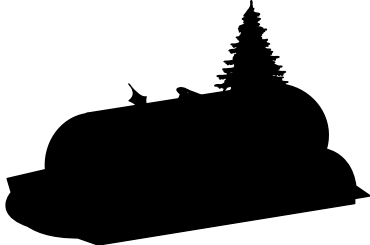
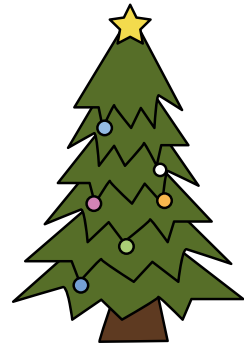
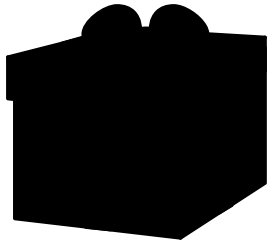

Put the number of Christmas items on each line and circle the image that holds the largest number.



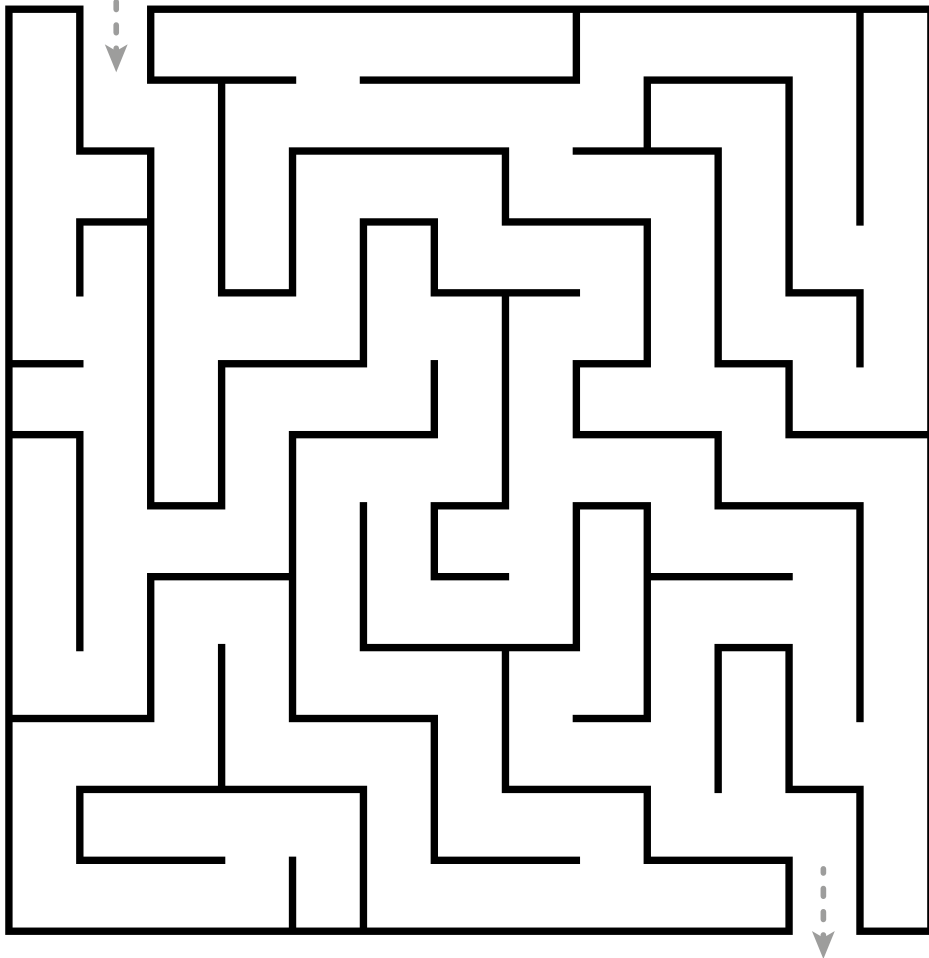


Maze

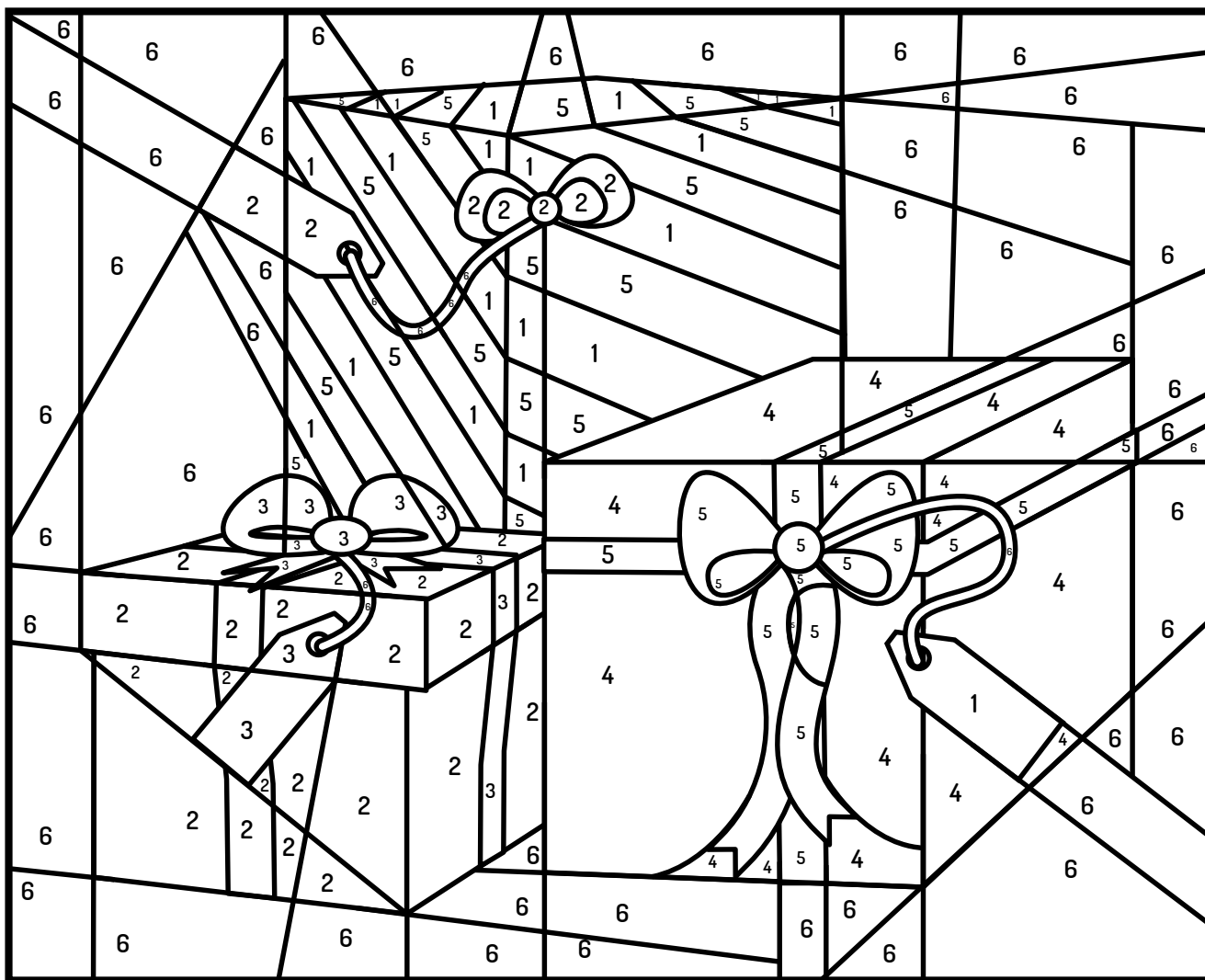

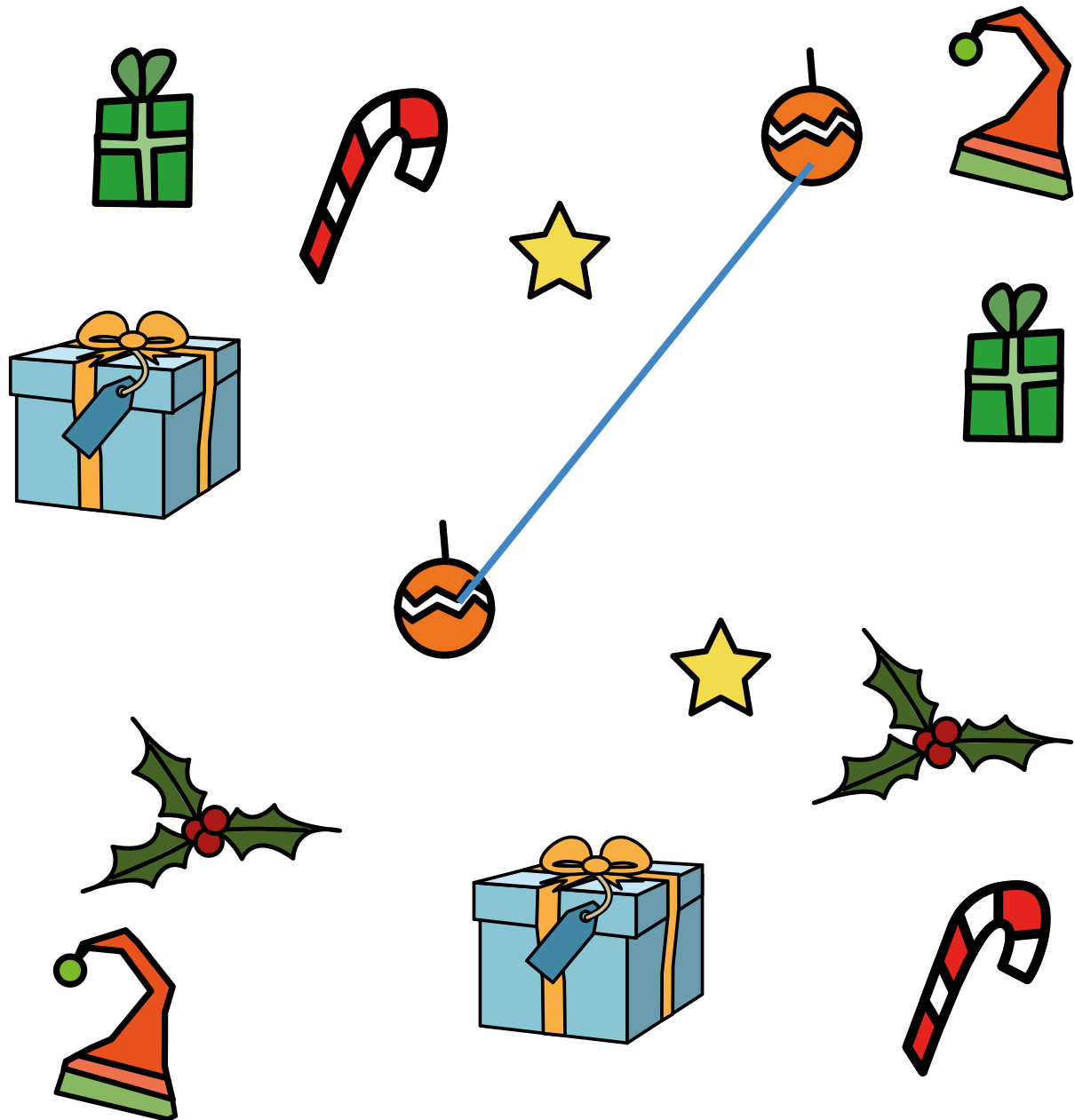
