
### Who are the dinosaurs?


The dinosaurs lived on earth there for **many years before man appears**. We known they have existed with their fossils and some scientists have been studying them.

Do you know what is a **dinosaur fossil**? This is the part of the backbone or skeleton of the animal which was preserved for thousands of years in the rock.









Indicates the number of dinosaurs on each line and surrounds the thumbnail that contains the greatest number.















