







Insects

Most insects have a body that consists of three parts: head, thorax and abdomen. They have six legs, four wings and two antennae. **Do you know any of the insects living in your garden?**










Count

How many black spots does the ladybird have altogether?




Cut and glue

Colour the shape, cut it out and form a dice by folding along the lines. Glue the shape together using the flaps.






Colour in without going over the lines




Train your memory




