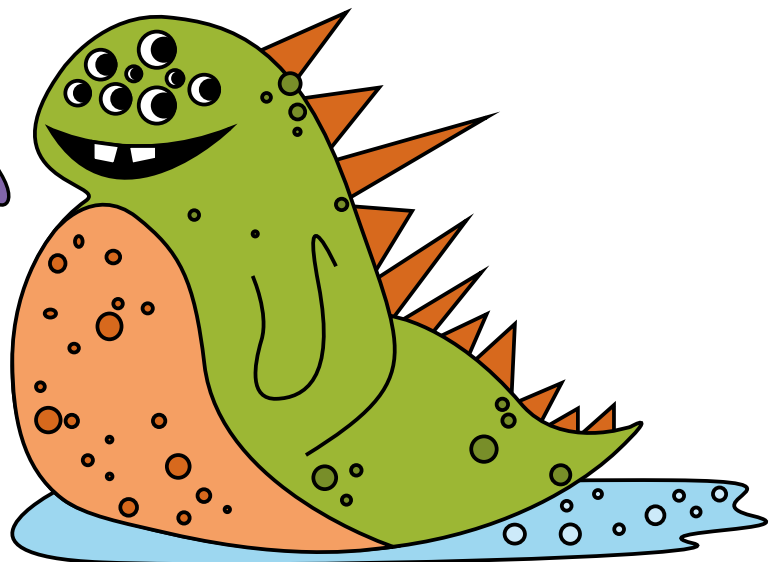
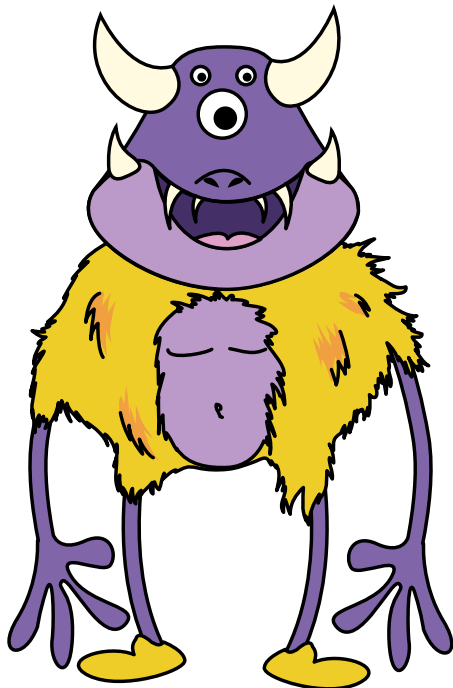


Monsters

Crossword

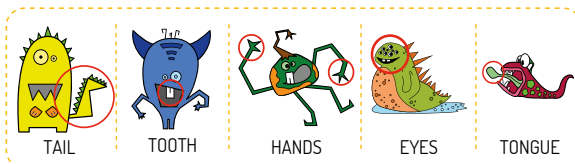
