It is a time for children and adults to enjoy **chocolate eggs** or **rabbits** but every country has its own traditions. So how do you celebrate Easter?



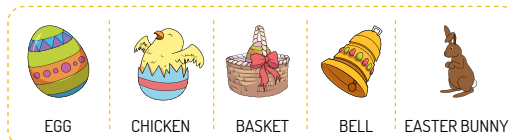
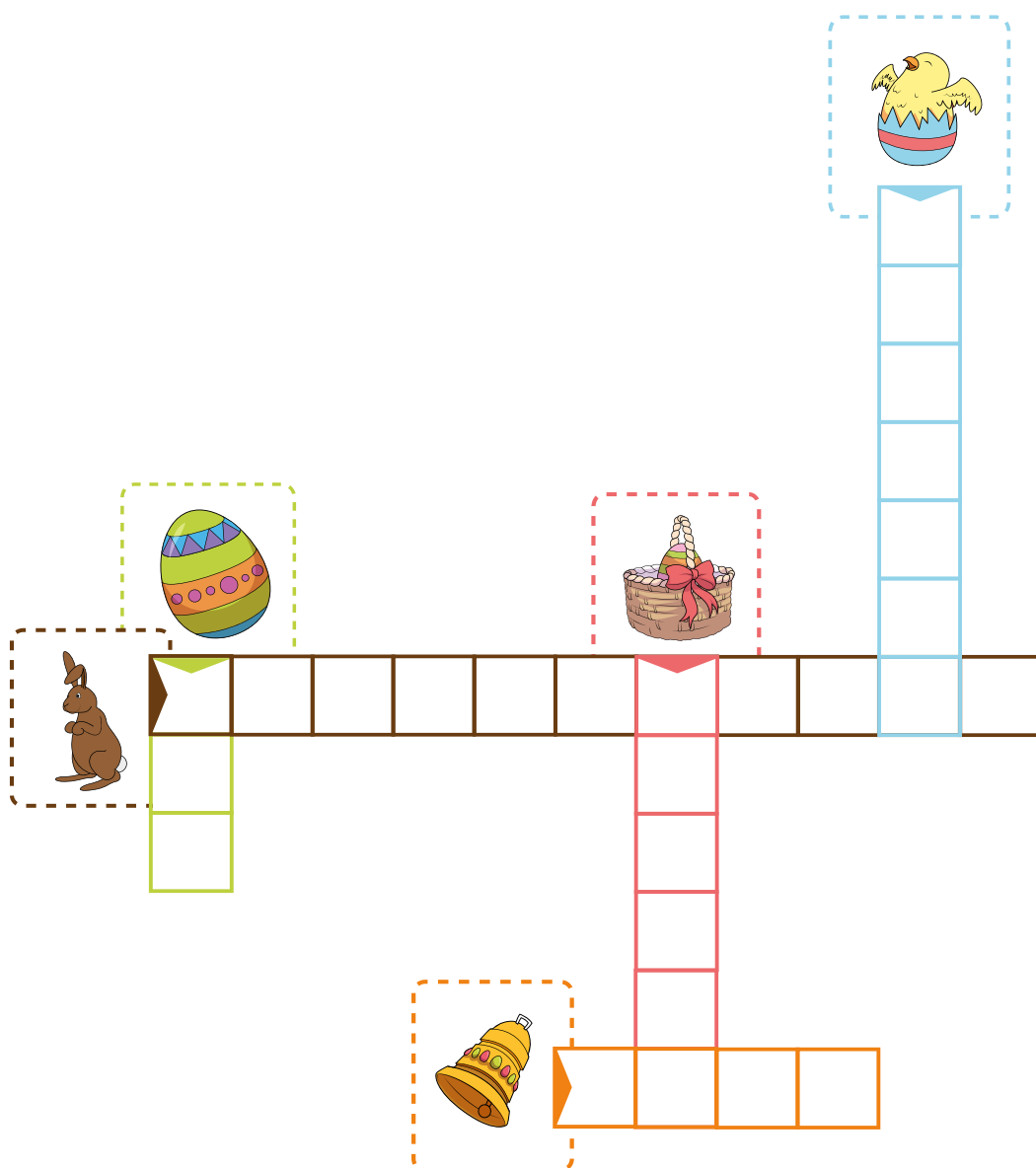

Cut and stick

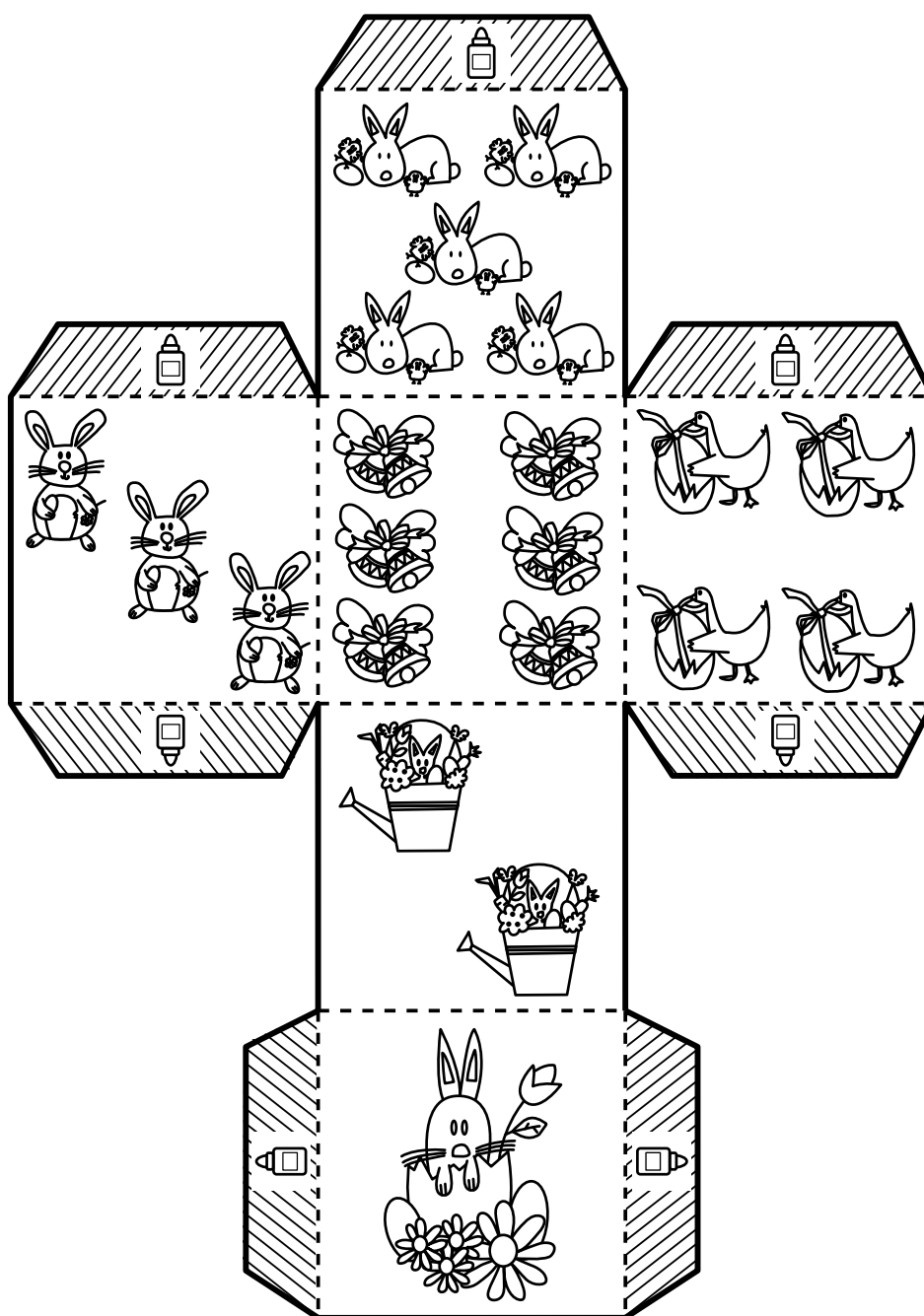

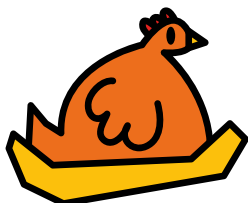

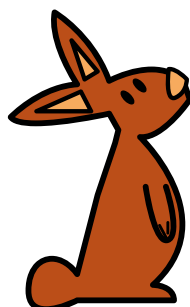
